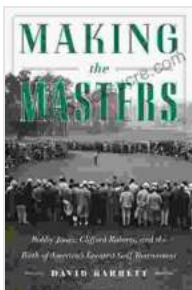


Bobby Jones: The Birth of America's Greatest Golf Tournament
