

In Memoriam: Dwayne Haskins, A Bright Star Extinguished Too Soon

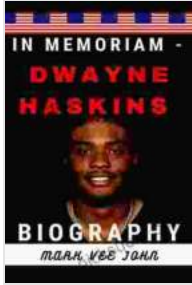

Dwayne Haskins was born on May 3, 1997, in Highland Park, New Jersey. He was introduced to football at an early age by his father, Dwayne Haskins Sr., a former college football player. Young Dwayne quickly developed a passion for the sport and spent countless hours practicing in his backyard.

NFL Career and Legacy



Haskins was selected 15th overall by the Washington Redskins in the 2019 NFL Draft. He started 13 games as a rookie and showed flashes of his potential but also faced some struggles. In 2020, he was benched in favor of Alex Smith and ultimately traded to the Pittsburgh Steelers.

With the Steelers, Haskins served as a backup quarterback to Ben Roethlisberger and Mason Rudolph. He started one game in 2021 and completed 6 of 13 passes for 63 yards.

Untimely Death and Aftermath



On April 9, 2022, Haskins was tragically killed when he was struck by a dump truck while walking on a Florida highway. The incident sent shockwaves through the NFL and beyond.

Haskins' death was met with an outpouring of grief and tributes from teammates, coaches, players, and fans. The NFL community mourned the loss of a young and promising player who had so much potential.

The Dwayne Haskins Legacy

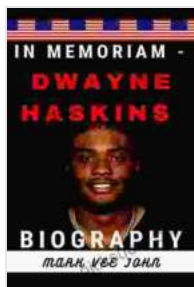
Despite his short life, Dwayne Haskins left an enduring legacy in the sport of football and beyond.

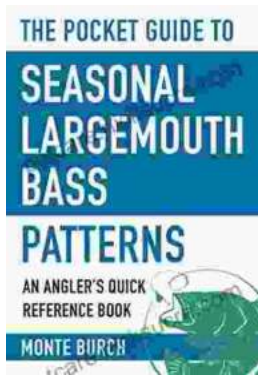

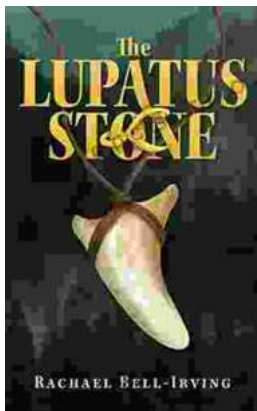
